

Frequently Asked Questions

Is this programme free?	Yes, 20/20 is fully funded. You are responsible for the cost of all travel and parking where relevant.
Will I get a place on the programme based on my job title i.e. the job I do for my organisation?	Places will be allocated based on the strength of the application, change challenge & line manager reference
Am I eligible?	If you work within the Frimley Integrated Health and Social Care System (ICS), you are eligible. If you work outside of the Frimley ICS but work with teams and individuals within the Frimley ICS, you are eligible. If you have a question about your eligibility, please contact Frimley Academy.
Can I appeal the decision if I haven't been offered a place on the programme?	We have fair transparent selection criteria in place. Our selection panel changes each year. The programme is always oversubscribed so a strong application with a reference stating reasons why you should be offered a place is crucial. The Panel decision is final.
Is it important to know about the Integrated Care System and their priorities?	Yes, it is helpful to know about the ICS/ICB and their priorities in order to consider what your Change Challenge might be, ie how will it benefit the System, the patient outcome, a pathway, something that can possible link in to a project you might already be working on. However, we understand that quite a few of you are from outside of the Health and Care arena, we'd ask that you think about your organisation's ambitions and priorities and the collaborative practices that it utilises when working across organisations, boundaries and services.
Do I have to attend all of the programme events?	Yes, if you want to receive your certificate at the end of the programme. The events run from 8.30-5pm and any caring responsibility arrangements need to be in place so you can stay until the end of the programme at 5pm or later if residential evening events.

	Holidays should not be booked during programme timings.
What is backfill and can I apply for it?	The backfill policy is in place to enable self-employed Independent Practitioner's to attend our programme, whilst still being able to ensure patient care is in place at their practice. It is not available to other applicants as their organisations will be releasing them to attend.
How does a GP apply for backfill?	Please contact Frimley Academy office to ensure that you know the procedure for being set up as a preferred supplier. After each event, you should send an invoice to frimley.academy@nhs.net and we will be able to organise payments. Please contact Tracy London on 075000 73853 for queries
Is it possible for an employee and their line manager to both do the programme at the same time?	Yes, we do allow this. You will be in separate action learning sets.
I'm currently completing another Frimley Leadership Programme; can I also apply for 20/20?	If you have completed a Frimley Academy programme, you will not be eligible to apply for another Leadership Programme run by the Frimley Academy for at least 2-3 years.
Is there an expectation to deliver something during this programme?
